November 5<sup>th</sup> 2024 marks 143 years since government troops and militia invaded the settlement of Parihaka. This year, we once again commemorate Parihaka as we continue to uphold the legacy of Te Whiti-o-Rongomai and Tohu Kākahi and acknowledge the sad, but special connection between Taranaki and Ōtepoti.

**You are warmly invited to join us for a dawn ceremony: 7 – 7.30 am Tuesday, 5<sup>th</sup> November at the Rongo Stone on Portsmouth Drive. (see map below)**

Plenty of parking is available, near the Rongo stone, in the Bayfield Carpark in Shore Street.

The kaupapa for this brief hui is remembrance and reflection, and this gathering is not a time for protest.
