Our annual Dunedin “**Raising of the Morning Star West Papua Flag**” public ceremony will take place at **5pm** on **Monday 1st December** in the **Octagon**. All members of our Parish and wider communities are warmly invited to attend this half-hour event. December 1st marks the first time the Morning Star flag was raised in 1961, a day of declared independence from the Netherlands.

- **Symbol of struggle:** The flag represents the ongoing struggle for West Papuan self-determination and independence, which was interrupted by Indonesian control in 1969.
- **Solidarity:** Raising the flag in New Zealand is a public show of support for West Papuans, who face harsh consequences for displaying it in their own territory.
- Mornington Methodist Church has a West Papua Flag on permanent display in our foyer as a sign of our commitment to West Papuan Independence.
